Kelly's Rules-Rights of People Receiving Developmental Services

'Kelly's Rules' is a training for self-advocates and their supporters. It begins with a discussion about the Maine Statute 34-B which gives rights to individuals who receive services from DHHS Developmental Services. A plain language version of the rights is used to frame the discussion and audience participation is a must! We ask for examples of each right and clarify what those rights cover and what they don't cover. The fun part of the workshop is in the role-plays. Trainers ask for audience participation to play out common scenarios where rights violations can happen. Role play topics include confidentiality, dignity and respect, right to privacy and person-centered planning. The audience will be asked to point out where rights violations happen and how they would speak up in that situation.
